Dear Parents and Guardians,

Year 4 Princess Theatre Visit - Tuesday 17th December

As part of our Trust Charter, we have organised a school trip for the Year 4 children to the Princess Theatre on Tuesday 17th December. We will be watching the Christmas Pantomime, *Jack and the Beanstalk*.

We will be walking to and from the theatre. We will be departing from Warberry at 8:45am and will return by 2:45pm to ensure that we are back at school ready for normal collection time.

All children should be in full school uniform for this trip and will need to bring a small backpack in which to carry their lunch, plus a named water bottle. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat as we are unable to guarantee the weather. If your child is eligible for FSM, you can order a packed lunch via the MS Form when it is sent out later.

To enable the activity to go ahead, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £8.35 which includes entry to the venue and the ticket cost. *Please be advised that if do not collect sufficient contributions, the visit may be unable to take place.* Please ensure payment is made promptly before the visit date. You will be able to make a card payment via the MCAS app when it goes Live at 6.00pm today. You will find the payment under Trips – click to enrol and pay. Please note that we are unable to accept cash payments.

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.
