Dear Parents and Guardians,

Year 6 “Me and Mrs Jones” Visit – Elder (2nd April) & Oak (3rd April)

All children should be in full school uniform for this trip. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat as we are unable to guarantee the weather.

To enable the activity to go ahead, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £5.00 towards the cost of breakfast. *Please be advised that if do not collect sufficient contributions, the visit may be unable to take place.* Please ensure contributions are made before the trip date. You can make a card payment via the MCAS app and will find the payment under Trips – click to enrol and pay. Please note that we are unable to accept cash payments.

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child’s medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child’s class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the ‘Parental Consents’ tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child’s participation.
