We are very excited to be launching Google Classroom for Year 1-6 as a means for setting homework each Friday. Google Classroom is an easy to use platform that allows teachers to set homework, children to complete learning, and then teachers to respond to completed tasks.

Google Classroom forms part of our contingency plan, should we find ourselves in another lockdown. By using the platform, we will be able to ensure that all children have access to a curriculum that mirrors the lessons taught in school. As weekly homework tasks will now be set through Google Classroom, children and families will have the time and opportunity to familiarise themselves with the layout.

All children have had an opportunity to access the virtual classroom in school and have a look at the features. The children are aware of the behaviour and commenting expectations when using the classroom, as well as any consequences of not following the rules.
