Spring Term

Year 3 Maths

Throughout the term, we will be continuing to develop our skills in using the four different operations. During the Spring term, there is going to be a focus on multiplication, grouping and sharing, and representing the operations visually.

The children will learn a variety of different strategies and methods to support them to multiply and divide. We will also be continuing to practise our table facts.

Year 3 English

During our English lesson sequences this term, the children will be learning all about writing to persuade.

We will start the term immersing ourselves in all different types of persuasive writing including newspaper advertisements, flyers, posters and television advertisements.

We will then be learning about text and sentence structures that help to persuade the reader and incorporate these in our own persuasive writing.

Reading

This term, to complement our writing curriculum, we will be reading examples of non-fiction writing in addition to our fiction extracts when this is appropriate. We will be continuing to retrieve information from text and to decode unfamiliar language to help us to understand the text we are reading. We will read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes.

Science

This term we will be focusing on, 'Animals including Humans'. The children will identify that animals, including humans, need the right amount and types of nutrition. They will also learn animals cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. Pupils will work scientifically by: identifying and grouping animals with and without skeletons and observing and comparing their movement; exploring ideas about what would happen if humans did not have skeletons; as well as comparing and contrasting the diets of different animals (including their pets).

Geography

This term in geography, we will be studying volcanoes and earthquakes. To understand why volcanic eruptions happen, it will be necessary to know about the structure of the Earth. They will understand that volcanoes are made when pressure builds up inside the earth. This affects the earth's crust causing magma to sometimes erupt through it. They will learn that earthquakes are caused when the earth's tectonic plates move against each other.

History

After the February half term break, we will be swapping our geography learning for history lessons. We will be exploring the contributions of the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain today.

We will make links to previous history topics to understand where in history the Romans fit in chronologically. We will research the significant figures - Caesar, Claudius, Boudicca and Constantine.

Religious Education

We will be identify some beliefs about God in Islam. We will make clear links between beliefs about God and ibadah (e.g., how God is worth worshipping; how Muslims submit to God). We will learn about some acts of ibadah (worship) in Islam (e.g. prayer, fasting, celebrating) and describe what they involve, as a family as a community, at home and in the mosque.

Physical Education

During our outdoor P.E. sessions, we are going to be continuing to develop our knowledge of invasion games. This term, we are going to be focussing on the sport of basketball, where the children will be able to learn a variety of different skills such as dribbling, passing, striking and working as part of a team.

In indoor P.E, we are going to be learning how to develop our skills in handball.

Music

This spring term, the children will be studying music with the assistance of Mr. Blurton who will be giving the whole class lessons where they will have the opportunity to play the ukulele. This promises to be a very exciting and very hands-on series of lessons!



Design and Technology

During the Spring term, we will be examining different 'shell structures' and discussing how we could use them to create: gift boxes, containers, desk tidies and disposable/recyclable lunchboxes.

The children will then decide which of these to create themselves for their
