

# Summer Term

## Maths

To start off our summer term, we are going to be learning about fractions. We will be focusing on understanding that a fraction represents part of the whole. The children will have the opportunity to explore parts of a whole, both of an object and of a number.



Throughout the term, we will be unpicking how to record and represent fractions correctly. This will then lead us nicely onto learning how to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

Following on from our fractions unit, we will be learning about angles, lines and shape. The children will be exploring parallel and perpendicular lines as well as types of angles.

We will be continuing to develop our times table fluency throughout the term with two daily test.

## English

During our English lesson sequences this term, the children will be learning all about writing to inform. We will be immersing ourselves in different types of media used to inform such as televised news reports, brochures, and various informative texts before drawing conclusions on their similarities and differences.



We are then going to be focusing on the structure of a non-chronological report which is a piece of text that isn't written in time order, they tend to be non-fiction and give information on subjects or events.

Our report will be focused to inform about the effect of earthquakes.

## Reading

In whole class reading, children will be continuing to develop their retrieval and explanation skills through exploring a variety of different texts. This half term, we are going to have a focus on non-fiction texts.

After half term, we will be focusing on famous traditional tales. This will allow the children to use their reading skills to explore language, authors' choices and messages behind different stories.

## Science

During the summer term, we will be learning all about plants. The children will be exploring the needs of plants through experimentation and careful observation over a period of time. The children will have a chance to grow a range of different plants and observe how plants differ. We will also be learning about seed dispersal and the purpose of different seed types.



## Geography

Our geography learning will be about cities. We will be learning about the main cities in the UK and comparing their geographical features.

During the second part of this half term, we will be discovering some of the cities of Italy. We will then explore the similarities and differences between the cities of the UK and Italy.



## History

In history, we are going to be focusing on the Battle of Britain and what impact this has had on Britain today. Throughout this learning, the children will be exploring where The Battle of Britain fits on our timeline of events in history, understanding how it started and ended and the impact that it had on British citizens.



## Religious Education

Our big question for this half term is 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'.

Throughout this unit, the children will have the chance to explore a variety of different stories that Jesus told in the Bible. This will allow the children to identify Christian beliefs and understanding of what Jesus wanted for God's world.



## Physical Education

During the first half of the summer term, the children will be learning and taking part in rounders for their outdoor PE session. They will learn to work as a team, and they will learn the difficult rules of rounders.

During the second half of the summer term, the children will be taking part in athletics during their outdoor PE session. They will be learning a range of different sports within the discipline of athletics.


## Art

We will be learning about how and why art was created thousands of years ago, making homemade paints from natural materials and replicating painting techniques from the past.



## Design and Technology

We will be designing, making and evaluating a personalised, programmable nightlight for themselves or another child



## Relationships and Health Education

This term, we are going to be focusing on physical health and mental wellbeing. This learning will allow the children to develop their understanding of themselves, both mentally and physically, exploring that there are a range of normal emotions that they may feel in different situations. This will allow them to understand how to recognize these emotions and encourage them to communicate to others in a way that feels comfortable for them.
