We are thrilled to be able to continue our commitment to offer a range of after school clubs this term. We are committed to providing a rich and exciting curriculum and we believe that our clubs will provide your child with a wide range of enrichment opportunities. Please ensure your child brings their named PE kit in a bag on their club day ready to change into at the end of the school day.

We have teamed up with Torquay United Community Sports Trust who will continue to offer a range of Year group clubs. The Trust runs a number of after-school clubs across South Devon, providing children with an added opportunity to engage in physical activity. Throughout the Autumn term, they will be offering football clubs for children in Years 3 & 4 and Years 5 & 6. This will give the young people the opportunity to have fun whilst learning and improving. They have a thorough knowledge of the curriculum requirements in PE and work in partnership with schools to ensure that they deliver lessons that are imaginative, informative and enjoyable.

**You can reserve a space in these clubs via the MCAS app from 6:00pm on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September.**

On Fridays, the team from Kinetic Sports will deliver Invasion Games for Years 3 and 4. Kinetic Sports Group specialise in delivering a wide array of traditional and alternative sports and find that the offering of alternative sports, as well as traditional sports, allows children of all abilities to discover, succeed and more importantly enjoy. **Throughout the year, the Kinetic team will change the Year groups for their Friday club – Years 1 and 2, keep an eye out for more information over the year.** Please note the staff from TUCST and Kinetic currently deliver PE lessons in school and strictly follow theirs and the Academy's risk assessments to ensure that all clubs are both enjoyable and safe.

### Frazoo:

Mrs Hulbert is offering Frazoo After School Club to Year 4 in September. Frazoo is an exciting, educational, animal experience with a variety of reptiles and invertebrates. Mrs Hulbert says:

"I am a fully qualified primary school teacher with 30 years teaching experience. I am fully vaccinated. I hold an enhanced DBS check and have public liability insurance.

The club will begin on Wednesday 12th September and run for 5 weeks at a cost of £45. The group size is limited to 10 children to reduce stress on the animals and ensure a high-quality experience. If I get more than 10 children applying, I will do a new club with the extra children in November. Please email me now to ask for a place, places will be allocated strictly in order of emails received to ensure fairness (I will check my junk mail etc every day as well).

The sessions will include handling the animals, a species information sheet, an in-depth talk and discussion covering a range of topics eg Conservation, Latin names, Habitats, Food Chains, Zoo Ethics and Care of Exotics. However, they will be discouraged from buying/owning exotics. The children will also receive a participation certificate at the end of the course. The children will wash their hands before and after handling the animals and use anti-bacterial hand-gel. The session will take place in a school classroom.

The club will run from 3:00pm-4:00pm in school. I will collect the children from class before the session and they must be collected on time afterwards. I am happy to escort children to After school Club.

Payment will be by bacs or cash/cheque(I do not need payment until the Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September). I will give you details of how to pay once you have secured a place for your child.

There are limited numbers of places available for these clubs which will be allocated strictly on a first come, first served basis.**

Once you are in the “Clubs” tab, please click on the required club and then click on “enrol now”. If all of the spaces have been taken, your child will be added to the waiting list and we will let you know if a space becomes available.
