

Autumn 1 2023 – Year 6 Curriculum

Maths

In maths, we will be securing the children's understanding of place value up to 10,000,000. We will be rounding up and down to nearest multiples, focusing on the power of 10 and still continue to incorporate our four operations throughout.

Science

In science, we are building on our prior knowledge of how circuits are made and developing that by asking the key question, how can circuits be represented and changed to create effect?

RE

In RE, we are exploring creation and science and asking the question, can they work together. We will be examining different sources and discussing reliability as well as exploring our own opinions on the challenging topic.

RHE

In RHE, we are focusing on families and friendships and how we can respect ourselves and others, whether that is inside or outside of school.

Reading

In reading, we are continuing to develop our comprehension skills focusing on the book *The Light in Everything* by Katya Balen. With help from Zofia and Tom and the DERIC toolkit, we are guided through the book and are able to explore the how's and why's of the authors vision.

History

In history, we are examining how the industrial revolution impacted our lives on a local level as well as global scale. We will be exploring life before the revolution and how our lives have changed after assessing all sides both positive and negative.

French

In French this half term, we are continuing to develop the children's understanding of phonics by focusing on the pronunciation of the key fundamental sounds.

English

In English, we have begun our term by diving off the *Peggy Sue* and into the world of *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo. We are focusing creating a narrative and exploring how we can write to entertain.

Art

In art, we are looking at the work of local artist Simon Drew and exploring how he incorporates humour into his art and how we can pastiche that into our own work. Simon Drew? What did he draw?

Computing

In computing this half term, we are investigating communicating and collaboration, with a focus on internet safety.

PE

In PE, we are building on our previous learning of gymnastics and developing our skills and core strength, as well as focusing on our teamwork.
