# Summer term 2024 - Year I Curriculum

### Maths

In maths, the children will be exploring the concept of measure through, height, length, mass, volume, and time. They will be consolidating their place value knowledge with numbers up to 100 and learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.

#### Science

As scientists this term, the children will be learning about animals including. Humans. We will be naming the parts of the body as well as identifying different types of animals, such as Reptiles and Mammals.

#### RE

As global citizens, the children will be thinking about what it means to belong to a faith community as well as considering the big question how should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?

### RHE

The children will be focusing on how to keep safe in the summer. We will be exploring how to keep ourselves safe in the warmer weather as well as keeping our bodies safe.

## Reading

To develop the skill of reading, all children access the RWI programme. This programme is structured around the learning and application of sounds (phonemes) and how these are represented written down (graphemes). The children will read the same book 3 times at school in a week and then bring it home to read. The children will also enjoy time in the library to choose their own book and to foster a love of reading.

# History

As historians, the children will be investigating the past through the big question, 'Why do we remember the moon landings?'. They will explore a range of sources, such as video clips and newspaper headlines to discover what happened in 1969. The children will learn about the astronauts who went to the moon and how the moon landing became a significant historical event.

### French

The children will be learning different shape names. They will use their prior learning of numbers and colours to describe the shapes. They will continue to practise French greetings, as well as counting to 10.

### English

As authors, the children will be focusing on consolidating the skills of writing they have learnt throughout their time in year I. They will be applying these skills to be able to write short stories and describe characters from books they are familiar with

### Art

As artists, the children will be exploring the global artist Antoni Gaudi. They will be using the medium of clay to create their own tiles and experiment with colour to decorate them.

# Computing

The children will be learning about programming through the application Scratch Junior where they will write simple code to programme a 'sprite'. The children will also have the opportunity to use Google Docs to practise typing.

#### PE

During outdoor PE, the children will be focusing on developing the skills needed to play an adapted version of volleyball. They will also be practising their athletic skills ready for sports day.
