

Summer Term 2024 - Year 5 Curriculum

Maths

During the first half of the term, the children will be focusing on shape and considering the different properties of shapes. They will be using protractors to measure angles as well as using skills of estimation.

Science

We will be learning about living things and their habitats. During this unit of learning, they will be learning about the different lifecycles including gestational periods.

RE

In RE, we will be reading through the scriptures of the Gospels to learn more about Christians' understanding of Jesus and his life.

RHE

In the first half of this term, we will be exploring health, mental health and wellbeing. The children will learn how to stay healthy and strategies for keeping mentally healthy too.

Reading

During the Summer term, we will be looking at a range of texts linked to our history and English learning. We will be focusing on narrative to begin with, giving the children a chance to read a range of descriptive and vocabulary rich writing.

History

In history, the children will be learning about the Benins. They will be finding out about the civilisation and compare it to the events that were happening elsewhere in the world whilst considering the impact that they had on their country and the world.

French

In French, the children will continue to practice reading, writing and speaking French as they look at the vocabulary needed to talk about 'The Home'.

English

To kickstart the term, we are going to be writing to entertain and using rich language as we consider our audience when writing a story inspired by the Michael Morpurgo book 'I believe in Unicorns'. During the unit, the children will have the opportunity to consider the life experiences of the main character.

Art

In art, we are going to be learning about national artist, Paul Thurlby. The children will be looking at the techniques that he uses to create his pieces and practicing these before going on to create a 2D letter in the same style.

Computing

At the beginning of the term, the children will be focusing on vector drawings and using a range of software to allow them to create and develop their own vector drawings.

PE

In PE this term, we will be working with sports specialists who will be delivering high quality lessons to further develop their strength and stamina.
