

# Autumn Term Home Learning Menu 2024 - Year 4

## Mathematics

- Complete the weekly maths activity
- Play TT rockstars every day for 10 minutes- can you become a rock legend!!!

## English - spelling and writing

- Learn your weekly spellings.
- How many words can you spell of the Statutory Spelling list for Year 3 and 4? Highlight the ones you can spell?
- Write your own version of one of our 'Favourite Five' books (Frostheart, Princess and the Pea, Journey, Spider and the Fly)

## English - reading

- Read at least 4 times a week and record it in your reading journal
- Share a story with family or friends who don't usually hear you read.

## Art/Music

Research the art of Henry Moore and produce a copy of part of a whole piece of his work in your own style: drawing, sketches or even a sculpture.

Write a song, maybe a harvest song, using an 'instrument' to accompany you. This can be performed in class if you feel brave and confident enough. (Or record it and send it in!)

## Science

Sound Go on a sound hunt around your house? Or go for a walk and listen very carefully. Create a table, chart or picture to show what you heard.

Electricity- Make a list of any toys or games in your home that are powered by electricity- don't forget toys/games with batteries. How do you think they work?

- We would like you to complete **all the core activities** above (Maths, English and Reading).
- Choose a **minimum of 3** topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting and present them however you wish: PowerPoint, fact file, poster, leaflet, photo, video etc.
- Record your Home Learning in your journal and share with your teacher.

## PE/French

- Invent your own invasion game and write the rules to share with the class (or teach it to them!)
- Practice throwing, catching, and kicking a ball.

## History /geography

Find out if anyone in your past was involved in WWII- create an information poster. Or go on a visit to the museum in Brixham and find out more about WWII.

Mountains- can you locate any mountains in the world and find out how tall they are. Where are the tallest mountains in the world? Create a table of all the information you have found out about mountains.

## RE/DT

Draw the 'Aum' symbol from Hinduism. Use drawings / explanations to reflect what it might mean to a Hindu. Do you have any pop-up books in your house? Can you see how they work and create your own pop-up card.
