## Mathematics

## English - spelling and writing

## Science

Uses of everyday materials- How many different materials can you find in your house? Do all the same materials have the same uses?

Living things and their habitats - Research one of the habitats you find interesting, this could be a coral reef, a rainforest, a woodland, the arctic etc, Find out as much information as you can about it. You can choose how you present this to share with the class.
