## Mathematics

- Please login to Times Table Rockstars and spend 5 minutes a day practising. (the children's Times Tables Rockstars account has the same login details as their Numbots account).
- Maths Weekly Homework Quiz.

## English - spelling and writing

- Learn your weekly spellings for a test on Friday.
- How many words can you spell of the Statutory Spelling list for Year 3 and 4? Highlight the ones you can spell.
- Practise your handwriting.

## English - reading

- Read at least 3 times a week and record it in your reading diary and read your RWI book every time it is changed (if applicable).
- Share a story with family or friends who don't usually hear you read.

## Art / DT / Music

- Create your own artwork inspired by Lascaux. Which natural resources will you use to make it?
- Create your own musical instrument using things that you have in your home.

## Science

Rocks - When you go out with your family, identify different locations where you can see rocks and soils and take a photo.

Light - Create your own shadow puppet. Can you shine the light on your puppet to create a shadow? Can you change the size of the shadow? Remember to take a photo!

## History / Geography

- Research the Stone Age, Bronze Age and the Iron Age. Can you find a secondary source linked to our learning to share with the class?
- Take a look at a map of Dartmoor. How do you think the land is used? Label your map to show your ideas.

## RE

Retell the Creation Story. You could do this by writing it, creating a comic strip using pictures.

- We would like you to complete **all the core activities** above (maths, English and reading).
- Choose a **minimum of 3** topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting and present them however you wish; PowerPoint, fact file, poster, leaflet, photo, video etc.
- Record your Home Learning and share with your teacher.

Topic activities can be handed in across the term until Christmas.

- Interesting project - create your own boardgame linked to an aspect of our learning in school.
- Write a review/recommendation about your favourite book. Why do you love it? Why should I read it?
