Mathematics

- Complete the weekly maths homework set and record it in your homework book.

English -spelling and writing

English - reading

Art/Music

Art- We will be looking at the work of Frida Kahlo this term and exploring how to use colour to symbolise feelings. Can you create a portrait of someone in your family or of a famous person and think carefully about what colours you want to choose to represent their thoughts and feelings.

Music- We are learning about how music can make us feel different emotions. Choose a song you are familiar with and create a poster explaining how it makes you feel.

- We would like you to complete all the core activities above (Maths, English and Reading).
- Choose a minimum of 3 topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting and present them however you wish, PowerPoint, fact file, poster, leaflet, photo, video etc.

History / geography

History- In history we are learning about the Vikings. You could create a poster about a particular part of the period that interests you, or you might want to have a go at creating a 3D Viking longboat.

Geography- Our key question for this term is, "how can we pinpoint locations at a global scale?" Choose a country within a different continent to ours to research and create a poster comparing them to either England or Europe.

Science

Forces and magnets:

This term, we will be looking at the different types of forces (friction, air resistance, water resistance and gravity). Have a go at conducting some experiments of your own and record the results to bring in and share with the class. You may wish to include photos or drawings. Don't forget to consider how you will make sure they are fair tests!

RHE/PE

In RHE, we will be learning about belonging to a community. Why don't you see if you can carry out an act of kindness within your community. This could be through holding doors open for others or arranging a beach clean-up. Be as creative as you like!

RE

In RE, we are exploring the question, what does it mean to be a Muslim in Britian today? Could you write a couple of paragraphs explaining why you think learning about different religions is important to you or to your community.
